BLOOD PRESSURE MEDICATION IN YOUNGER WOMEN

You have been directed here because you are a woman aged under 50 and are taking a medication in the ACE inhibitor (eg Lisinopril or other drug ending 'pril) or Angiotensin receptor blocker (eg Candesartan or other drug ending 'sartan).
